# MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS MARION COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES BOARD

Thursday, January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2019

The Board of Directors of Marion County Emergency Services (911) Board met to conduct a regular meeting on Thursday, January 10<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 PM at the Marion County 911 Communications Center, 3246 Highway 61, Hannibal, MO.

### **Call to Order:**

Chairman Durand called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

#### **Approval of Minutes:**

The December 13, 2018 Board Meeting minutes were reviewed. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Dot Lake and seconded by Mike Dobson. Motion carried unanimously on a roll-call vote.

After discussing the benefits of AVL tracking of responder vehicles and apparatus, a motion to expend up to \$38,500 for the deployment of two AVL modems and one laptop with mapping software per agency in Marion County - pending the Directors assurance that the funds can be lawfully expended for this purpose - was made by Darrell McCoy and seconded by Richard Cerretti.
